

COVID-19: Screening Checklist for Visitors and Employees

This form has been adapted based on the CDC guidance on restricting nursing home visitors.

ALL individuals going past the lobby.

Employees, family, visitors, students entering the building must be asked the following questions:

1. Has this individual washed their hands or used alcohol-based hand rub on entry?

YES NO – please ask them to do so

2. Do you have any of the following symptoms?

- Fever
- Sore throat
- Cough
- New shortness of breath
- New loss of taste or smell
- Chills

If YES to any, restrict them from entering the building.

For anyone passing the lobby, check temperature and document results

3. Has anyone in the family been exposed to anyone thought to have had COVID-19 or tested positive for COVID-19?

4. Is the student being transferred from a center that has been closed due to a confirmed case of COVID-19?
